

# MSC INTERNATIONAL MARKET ACCESS

(TOP-UP, 90 CREDITS)

Our new course is designed for students who have completed the European Market Access University Diploma (EMAUD) and now wish to top up their qualification to masters level. Taking place over two years, the course offers training in research methods and economic evaluation. You'll also have the opportunity to demonstrate your research skills through an independent, masters level dissertation.

This is a part-time course which offers online and remote learning support throughout your studies, giving you flexibility around your professional and personal commitments.

- Our course is part-time to help you fit studying around your personal and professional commitments
- We teach you via blended learning, including online sessions and face-toface tutorials. This includes one weeks' teaching and learning in our awardwinning Brooks Building. The rest of the course, focused mainly on research dissertation, will be completed entirely online.

## **CORE UNITS**

# Research Methods and Economic Evaluation.

You'll develop a critical understanding of both quantitative and qualitative research methods, and consider ethical implications when conducting research. Your economic evaluation studies will include common methods used to undertake economic analysis, including cost utility analysis and cost effectiveness analysis. This core unit will take place over a one week block delivery starting on 9th September 2019.

#### Dissertation

You'll be able to showcase your increased skills in independent research through a masters-level dissertation. Collaborating with a sector-based partner, you'll apply approaches to research and economic evaluation to a dissertation project relevant to your practice.

#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

Applicants must have completed the EMAUD and have IELTs of 6.5 or equivalent (with no element below 6.0 or equivalent.)
